

STANDARDS FOR A HOMM MEMBER

Basic qualifications essential for every potential mission member are a heart of God and a teachable attitude. These underlie all the following guidelines in determining if an individual qualifies for the member of HOMM :

SPIRITUAL MATURITY

The applicant must have been a Christian for at least one year before beginning his/her active ministry with HOMM projects and must understand and be in full agreement with our ministry objectives.

CALL

The applicant must be able to state clearly how and why he/she believes God is calling him/her to the mission project.

EFFECTIVENESS OF WITNESS

The applicant must demonstrate a concern for others and a willingness to learn how to introduce others to Christ

KNOWLEDGE OF SCRIPTURE

The applicant must have a basic knowledge of Scripture and is expected to attend the home church regularly.

CHARACTER

The applicant must have leadership qualities, be attractive to others in personality and character, or manifest potential in these areas. Priority is placed upon dependability, willingness to assume responsibility, a teachable spirit, a good reputation and moral purity.

EMOTIONAL MATURITY

Adjusting to new culture, one must be willing to adapt to their culture with joyful heart.

SKILLS AND TRAINING

The applicant must have either the necessary formal education or on the job training to meet the demands of the assignment. In most cases, a college degree is required with some involvement with medical background.

PHYSICAL QUALIFICATIONS

The applicant must demonstrate the ability to meet the physical demands of assigned place.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

The applicant must be neat, well-groomed and willing to dress according to the standards of mission team policy.
